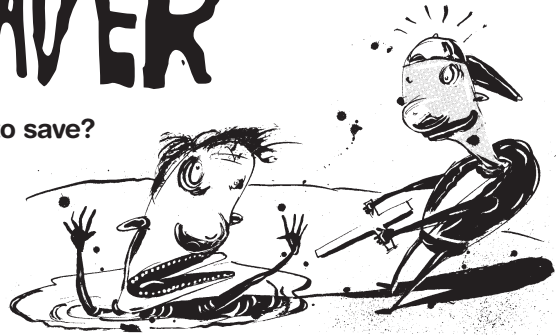


BE A LIFESAVER
