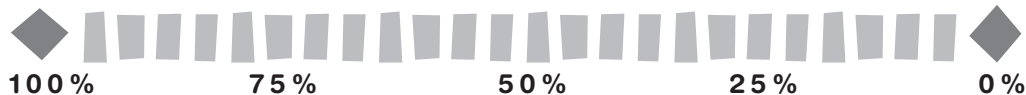


# CORRUPTION ABDUCTION
